

Hay Hutch

Net fitting instructions and tips

1. Place net inside Hay Hutch.
2. Locate a top corner.
3. Thread cord in from the outside choosing a hole BETWEEN feed apertures. (This is so that the join does not end up in an aperture.)
4. Thread through three top loops of the net and then out through the NEXT BUT ONE hole.
5. Thread cord back in through the NEXT hole and repeat.
6. When you get back to the beginning, tie off in a slip proof, tight knot.
7. Repeat at the base.

Notes / tips:

1. The net will reduce spillage and slow hay intake but, particularly on the Large, horses may not be able to clear up all of the forage to the centre. Just make it part of the refill routine to spin the left forage out as you refill.

Alternatively, you can place an item in the middle of the Hay Hutch - an upturned bucket or maybe a traffic cone.

2. If you want more “give” in the net, it can be threaded with 5mm bungee cord. Available from hardware stores/website or Amazon.
